The East Coke County Hospital District Board of Directors met for a regular meeting on Monday, April 27, 2020, at 5 pm in the patio area of the Bronte Health and Rehab Center. President Howard Baker presided over the meeting. Other board members present included Lanette Fletcher, Gina McCutchen, and Jerita Taylor. Administrator Daisy Toms, Chief Financial Officer Johnny Mathis, and Business Office Manager Fran Sonnenberg were also present. Everett Bedford was absent.

The meeting was called to order at 5 pm by President Baker.

A quorum was established.

Prayer was led by President Baker.

There public were no comments.

The minutes of the March 24, 2020, meeting were reviewed. Lanette Fletcher moved that the minutes be approved Gina McCutchen presented. seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.

Everett Bedford arrived at the meeting.

Ms. Toms presented the report

on behalf of Ms. Valadez. She also reported that we have a plan of action for an isolation room in place if one of our residents should contract Covid-19. We are lacking the negative pressure machine but it is on backorder with the suppliers.

Ms. Toms reported that we have 28 residents. We currently have two CNA openings, one daytime shift and one nighttime shift. All non-nursing staff members are limited to 37 1/2 hours per week at this time due to the low census.

We have received two payments from the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act Provider Relief Fund. One was directly deposited to our account for \$9,381.44 and one was a paper check for \$39,553.36. Since there are strict guidelines for use of these payments, the board suggested that the payments be transferred to the savings account for the present.

President Baker requested that Ms. Toms send a weekly report to board members. Ms. Toms asked for input from the board for what particular topics and/or information that they would like
