Commissioner Robertson reported on the update to the inside of the Robert Lee Senior Citizens Building by Ann Hedges and her spouse, as well as the hope to paint the outside. Judge Spain went over the tax values sheet with the Commissioners that was provided by the Appraisal District. Judge Spain reported on the information to be given about the upcoming Covid-19 testing to be held in Coke County on May 2. Judge Spain reported on the Infrastructure Grant Program, along with due dates and requirements that need met for the application to be turned in. Commissioner Millican reported on a barricade being placed on a county road by CRMWD, with the markings of a temporary closure being listed, and that it will be asked to be removed immediately.

Commissioner Williams moved to approve action on the payment of bills and was seconded by Commissioner Robertson. The motion carried.

Judge Spain adjourned the meeting at 10:47 am.

ECCHD meeting minutes told

The East Coke County Hospital District Board of Directors met for a regular meeting on Monday, April 27, 2020, at 5 pm in the patio area of the Bronte Health and Rehab Center. President Howard Baker presided over the meeting. Other board members present included Lanette Fletcher, Gina McCutchen, and Jerita Taylor. Administrator Daisy Toms, Chief Financial Officer Johnny Mathis, and Business Office Manager Fran Sonnenberg were also present. Everett Bedford was absent.

The meeting was called to order at 5 pm by President Baker.

A quorum was established. Prayer was led by President Baker.

There were no public comments.

The minutes of the March 24, 2020, meeting were reviewed. Lanette Fletcher moved that the minutes be approved as presented. Gina McCutchen seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.

Everett Bedford arrived at the meeting.

Ms. Toms presented the report

on behalf of Ms. Valadez. She also reported that we have a plan of action for an isolation room in place if one of our residents should contract Covid-19. We are lacking the negative pressure machine but it is on backorder with the suppliers.

Ms. Toms reported that we have 28 residents. We currently have two CNA openings, one daytime shift and one nighttime shift. All non-nursing staff members are limited to 37 1/2 hours per week at this time due to the low census.

We have received two payments from the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act Provider Relief Fund. One was directly deposited to our account for \$9,381.44 and one was a paper check for \$39,553.36. Since there are strict guidelines for use of these payments, the board suggested that the payments be transferred to the savings account for the present.

President Baker requested that Ms. Toms send a weekly report to board members. Ms. Toms asked for input from the board for what particular topics and/or information that they would like

Coke County Commissioners Court meetings held

The Coke County Commissioners Court held a regular meeting on April 28, 2020, at 9 am at the courthouse in Robert Lee. Those in attendance included County Judge Hal Spain, Commissioner Precinct 1 Donald Robertson, Commissioner Precinct 2 Paul Williams, Commissioner Precinct 3 Marshall Millican, Commissioner Precinct 4 Joe Sefcik and Deputy Clerk Jennifer Burdett.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag and prayer was offered by Commissioner Williams.

Judge Spain announced the presence of a quorum.

Commissioner Millican moved to approve the minutes. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Robertson and carried.

Judge Spain moved to reinstate the burn ban and was seconded by Commissioner Millican. The motion, opposed by Commissioner Williams and Commissioner Sefcik, carried.

Commissioner Millican moved to approve the purchase of an updated Arcview Mapping Program for 911 addressing. It would be considered as a budget amendment and unforeseen expense to be paid from road and bridge reserve funds. The action died for a lack of a

second. It was considered to take action concerning an emergency disaster declaration for Coke County. No action was taken.

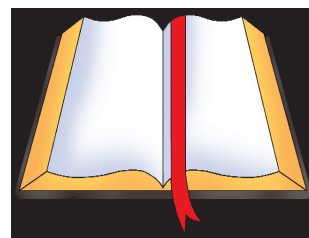
