**DECLARATION OF DISASTER AND ORDER** PROHIBITING OUTDOOR **BURNING FOR COKE** COUNTY, TEXAS

WHEREAS, t h e Commissioners' Court of Lost black Angus bull Coke County, on this the 12th after fire. V on left hip. day of May, 2011 has determined that Coke County, has been affected by recent wildland fires and continues to be threatened by high or extreme wildland fire hazard. This threat is caused by Call abundant fuel and extreme dry and windy conditions across the State of Texas and in Coke County, and;

WHEREAS, t h e Commissioners Court of County Coke have determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or plumbing, drain cleaning, rehabilitate property;

disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the County Clerk of Coke County.

4. Pursuant to Section 418.108 (d) of the Government Code, this Declaration of a local state of disaster activates the Coke County Emergency Management Plan.

5. The purpose of this order is the mitigation of the hazard posed by wildfires by curtailing the practice of outdoor burning, which purpose is to be taken into account in any enforcement action based upon this order.

BE IT THEREFORE ORDERED that the following emergency regulations are hereby established for all unincorporated areas of Coke County, Texas for the duration of the declaration;

(1) Actions Prohibited:

(a) All outdoor burning of any combustible material is prohibited. A person violates this order if he burns any combustible material or orders suchburning by others.

(b) The sale and use of all fireworks.

(2) Actions Allowed

(a) Any propane cooking, and outdoor cooking fires as long as they are under the supervision and control of an authorized Volunteer Fire Department.

(3) Enforcement:

(a) Upon notification of suspected outdoor burning, the fire department assigned to the location of the fire shall respond to the scene and take immediate measures to contain and/or extinguish the fire.

(b) As soon as possible, a duly-commissioned peace officer shall be sent to the scene to investigate the nature of the fire.

(c) If in the opinion of the officer at the scene and/or

the Fire Chief, the goal of the order can be attained by informing the responsible party about the

prohibitions established by this order, the officer may, at his discretion, notify the party about the provisions of this order and request compliance with it. In such instances, an entry of the notification shall be made into the dispatchers log containing the time, date, and place of the warning, and the name of the person receiving the warning.

(4) At the discretion of the peace officer and/or Fire Chief, subsequent or flagrant violations of this order may be prosecuted in accordance with the statues and procedures governing misdemeanors.

BE IT ALSO ORDERED that this order may be enforced by any dulycommissioned peace officer and that the venue for prosecution of this order will be the Justice of the Peace Court, Coke County, Texas.

This Declaration and Order shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance and continue until the conditions requiring this declaration and order are over, with the exception granted to fireworks under Section 418.108 (i) of the Government Code unless ratified and extended by the Governor of the State of Texas.
