RLISD Board meets in regular session

The Robert Lee ISD Board of Trustees met Tuesday, May 19, 2015, for a regular meeting. The meeting was held in the Robert Lee ISD Conference Room 119 at 5 pm. The meeting was called to order by President Wes Washam.

Members present included Wes Washam, Jeffie Roberts, Beverly Sinclair, Tom Sawyer, George Grim, and Erin Oleksiuk. Irma Torres was absent.

The invocation and pledge were led by Erin Oleksiuk.

Tom Sawyer made a motion to approve the minutes of April 21, 2015, seconded by Erin Oleksiuk. All voted for.

Jeffie Roberts made a motion to approve the financial reports given by Robin Allen and to approve the bills. The motion was seconded by Erin Oleksiuk. All voted for.

The Board signed their Conflict of Interest Disclosures.

Robin Allen swore in Wes Washam, Tom Sawyer and George Grim as Board Members.

George Grim made a motion to keep the board organized the same for 2015-2016. Wes Washam, President, Tom Sawyer, Vice President and Jeffie Roberts, Secretary. The motion seconded by Erin Oleksiuk. All voted for.

David O'Dell gave the high school principal report; enrollment for grades 7-12 was 105 and attendance rate was 96.6% for the month of April. Supt. Hood also gave the elementary principals report; elementary enrollment for April was 164 students and 96.3% attendance rate.

Supt. Hood recommended signing the Interlocal Agreement with West Texas Food Service Coop through ESC Region 17 for the 2015-2016. Tom Sawyer made a motion to approve this recommendation, seconded by George Grim. All voted for.

Supt. Hood recommended setting breakfast and lunch prices for the 2015-2016 school year as follows: Student breakfast will be \$1.70, Adult breakfast will be \$2.20; K-6 student lunch will be \$2.40, 7-12 student lunch will be \$2.65, Adult lunch \$3.35. Jeffie Roberts made a motion to approve the recommendation of breakfast and lunch prices, seconded by Erin Oleksiuk. All voted for.

Supt. Hood recommended a two year Extension of Depository Contract with Robert Lee State Bank for 2015-2017. Beverly Sinclair made a motion to approve the recommendation, seconded by Tom Sawyer. All voted for.

Supt. Hood recommended renewal of Voluntary Student/Athletic Accident Insurance Plan with The Brokerage Store. Erin Oleksiuk made a motion to approve the recommendation, seconded by

George Grim. All voted for.

Supt. Hood gave his respective report on enrollment numbers, update on budget process, facilities update, and graduation.

Supt. Hood read resignation letters from Sally Gloria and Heather Wyatt, effective May 29, 2015. Jeffie Roberts made a recommendation, seconded by Tom Sawyer, to accept the resignations with regret. All voted for.

The next regular board meeting will be Thursday, June 23, 2015, at 12 noon.

The meeting was adjourned 5:46 p.m.

the general membership at their next meeting June 4.


VP Scholarships
