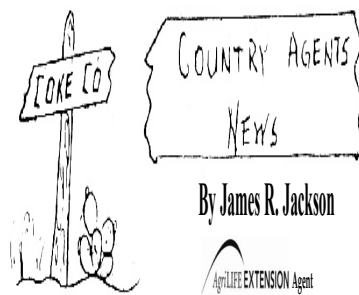

The Never Ending Battle

Now that all the mesquite trees have clothed themselves for another year and most of the trees throughout the county have gone through the process of going from the bright green to a darker olive green, landowners/property managers are starting to think about

spraying the trees.

The first order of business in spraying mesquites is to let the soil temp reach 75 degrees at a depth of 12 inches deep. I don't expect many of us to have a soil thermometer to be able to reach to that depth; however, an easier way to determine this is to look at the color of the leaves.

When a mesquite tree puts on leaves at the first of the year, the color of the leaves is a bright green. As spring goes on, the color of the leaves starts to change from spray starts to change from bright green to a duller olive green. When the leaves appear this color, it is a sign that the soil temp

is reaching 75 degrees. At this point, you are clear to conduct foliar spraying and you will maximize your kill rate.

A well tested spray mixture for foliar spraying mesquites is using 1/2% Reclaim, 1/2% Remedy, 1/4% Surfactant and 1/4% blue dye. Using this method, it is necessary to cover all leaves of the trees to the point where they are wet but not dripping.

A method that can be used throughout the growing season is the stem spray method. This method calls for a mixture of 20% Remedy with 80% diesel and it is most effective.
