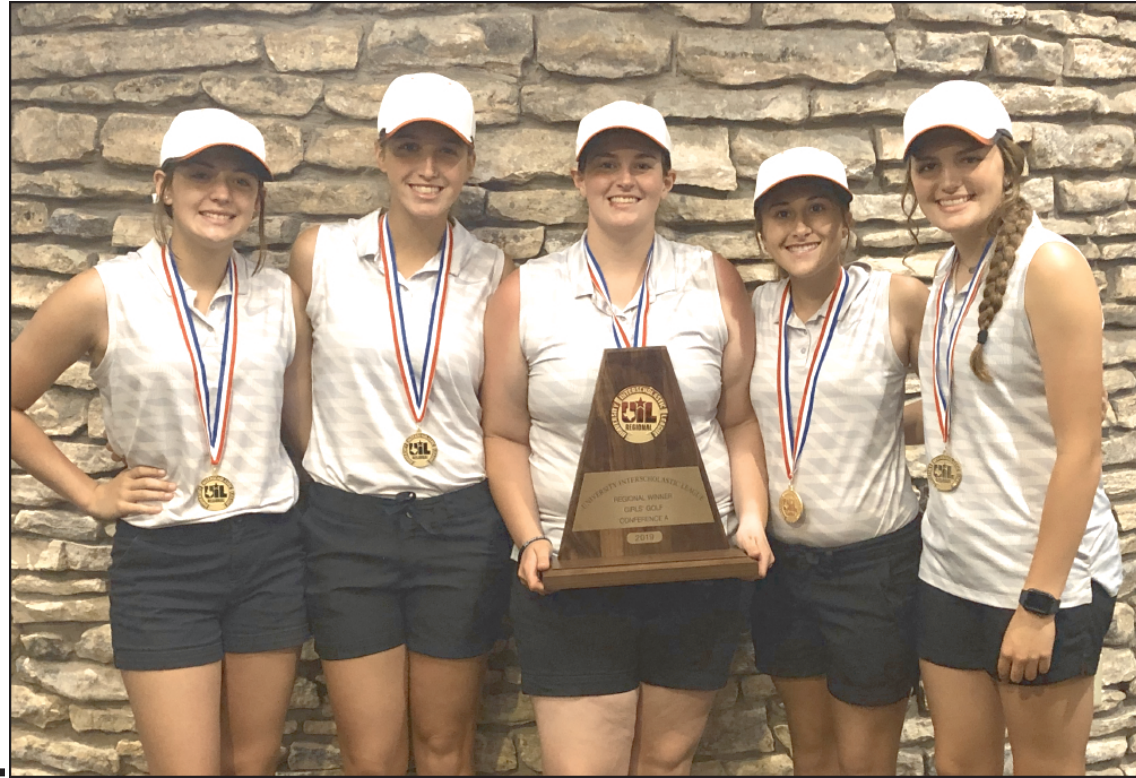
## Local elections to be held Saturday, May 4

Local entity elections will be held on Saturday, May 4, with voting taking place from 7 am until 7 pm.

The City of Robert Lee will hold an election for three two-year terms and one special election for a one-year unexpired term. Incumbents on the ballot include Ricky Green and Ann Hedges. They both filed for the two-year term seats. They will be joined on the ballot by Manuel Abalos, Tracy Grantham, David Lewis, Becca McGuire, and Jason Moran. Zachary Van Tine and Wyatt Hopson have filed for the one-year term. Voting will take place at the Coke County Courthouse in Robert Lee.

Bronte ISD will also hold an election to elect two members to the Board of Trustees. These are three-year terms currently held by Shane Kelton and Josh Schoenfield. Schoenfield has filed to retain his seat. He will be joined on the ballot by David McWright and TJ McCullough. Voting will be held at the Bronte Senior Citizens Building, located at 613 E. Oliver.

Robert Lee ISD has called a Bond Election for \$6,000,000 for improvements to the school. Please see the separate article detailing the proposed bond in the April 12 issue of *The Observer/Enterprise*. Voting will be held at the County Courthouse in Robert Lee.

## Tire recycling dates set for Coke County

## RLISD to hold pre-registration May 6

Robert Lee Independent School District will hold Headstart, Pre-K, and Kindergarten pre-registration on Monday, May 6, 2019, from 5:30 pm until 6:30 pm in the elementary school office. Prospective Pre-K students must be 4 years old by September 1, 2019, to be eligible for the 2019-2020 school year.

Documents needed for Headstart will be proof of all family income, proof of age, child's shot record, SNAP (if

applicable), and proof of Medicaid, CHIP, or Private Health Insurance.

All new students to RLISD (Pre-K through 6th grade) are encouraged to attend. Required documentation for enrollment will include birth certificate, social security card, and current immunization records.
