J. E. was a member of the First Baptist Church of Robert Lee, the Ex-P.O.W. Organization, the American Legion, and Beefmaster Breeders United.

He was preceded in death by his parents; his wife; his daughter, Bonnie Kaye Walker; his brothers, Clebert Quisenberry, Walter Quisenberry, and Bobby Quisenberry.
