Coke County Water Supply Corporation awarded grant

The Texas Water Resources Institute (TWRI) announced on December 19, 2019, that it has awarded a grant of \$300,000 to the Coke County Water Supply Corporation (CCWSC) to develop a water conservation program. The grant will be used to fund a variety of projects, including the installation of water-saving devices in homes and businesses, the development of a water conservation curriculum for schools, and the implementation of a water conservation audit program for businesses. The CCWSC is a non-profit organization that provides water supply services to the residents of Coke County. The grant is part of TWRI's ongoing efforts to promote water conservation and sustainable water management across the state.
