The Education Seminars will run from 8:30 a.m. to noon on July Saturday, 11, 2015. representing Individuals universities, ranches, non-profit government organizations, agencies, and industry may apply. Presentations should be related to wildlife, fisheries, habitat management, or similar topics. No commercial products may be advertised or endorsed. Submissions will be reviewed by a committee. Presentations will be selected based on the interests of conference attendees and the time frame allotted. Presenters will be asked to allow their presentation to be recorded.


