Looking to an increased demand for food this summer, Coke County Farm Bureau (CFB) is encouraging Coke County residents to consider donating cash or a non-perishable food item to their local food pantry.

“During the school year, most kids are guaranteed at least two meals a day at school. When school is out for the summer, some families do without or visit their local food pantry to ensure their needs are met,” John Ross Copeland, Coke CFB president, said. “That creates increased demand on food banks, which rely heavily on donations.”

Canned foods, dried beans, rice and other items are welcomed by most food pantries.

“We support our community and everyone in it,” John Ross said. “We hope you will, too.”
