Mr. Silver advised new member Josh Schoenfield that he will need to complete the New Board Member Training offered by the Region 15 Service center. The June Board Meeting will be held on June 9th at 7 p.m.

Mr. Siler presented the finances of the district to the Board. The District appears to be on-track financially for this year's budget. Declining enrollment and delinquent taxes are still presenting issues. He advised Bronte ISD is currently the 10th smallest district in Region 15. Mr. Siler has advised he will actively pursue a push to increase enrollment, including possible advertising opportunities. Mr. Siler also advised the AC replacement is still something that needs to be addressed, but the teachers have been great about

accommodating any situations that have come up. Mr. Siler also mentioned that some of the items from the early 2016-2017 year have been included in this year's budget.

Mr. Siler discussed possibly moving the location of the administration office to the elementary school principal offices. Advantages to the move included having a more centrally located principal office and more secure elementary school entrance. Disadvantages included access to communication equipment and an empty high school principal office. No decision was made.

The Board entered into executive (closed) session at 8:30 pm to discuss personnel issues.
