## 6th Annual Clay Antilley Invitational Tournament set for Saturday

The 6th annual Clay Antilley Invitational Golf Tournament is slated for Saturday, June 22, 2013, at Mountain Creek Golf Club in Robert Lee. The tournament, honoring Clay's memory, raises money for the Golf Scholarship Fund. This year, \$9,000 was given in scholarships. Over the last few years, over \$30,000 in scholarships has been awarded. Clay, the son of Tommy and Kei Antilley and a favorite son of Robert Lee, was extremely active in golf, 4-H, and FFA.

The tournament will have two tee times, 8:30 am and 1 pm. A lunch will be provided for golfers and their families at 12 noon. The tournament will be a shotgun start, three person select shot with prizes given in three flights for the top two teams and one of Clay's Git'R Done trophies for a team to be selected from the remaining teams. A long drive and closest to the pin prize

will also be given.

Following the tournament, there will be a dinner for the players, families and contributors to the tournament. The night's entertainment will be provided by Rough Creek and Krowhaven.

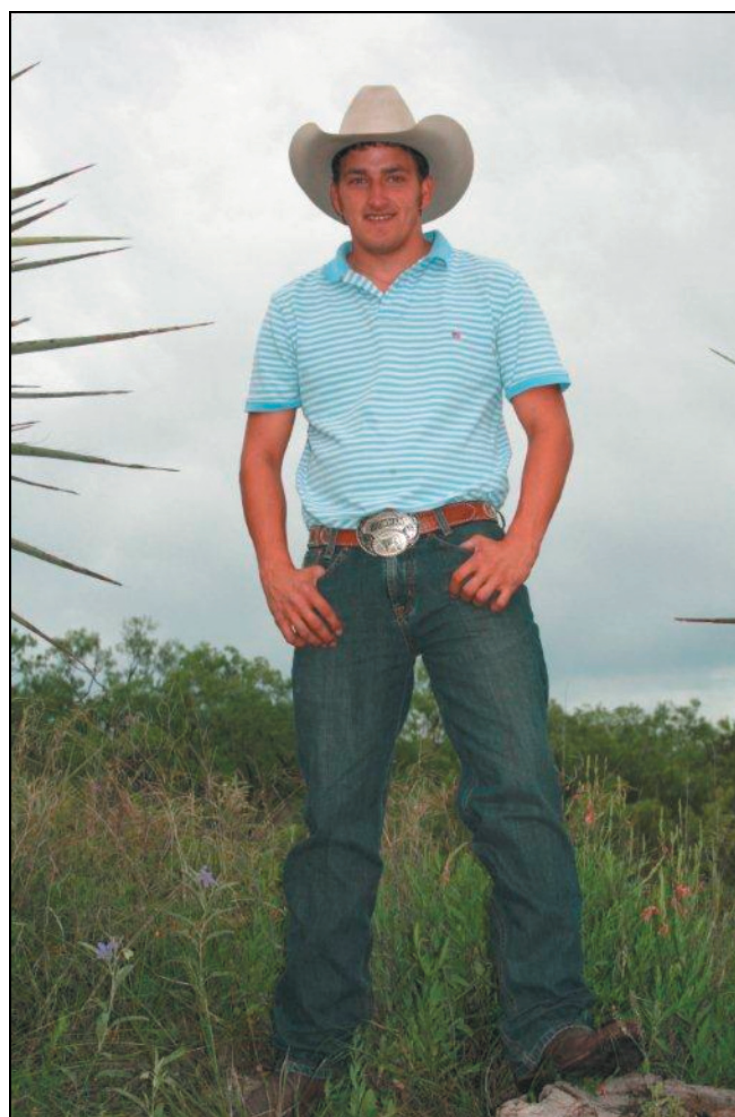
### County 4-H Camp slated
