**STATE OF TEXAS  
COUNTY OF COKE  
ORDER PROHIBITING  
CERTAIN FIREWORKS  
IN UNINCORPORATED  
AREAS OF COKE  
COUNTY, TEXAS**

WHEREAS, the Texas Forest Service has determined that drought conditions exist in Coke County; and

WHEREAS, on the 10th day of June, 2013, the Commissioners Court of Coke County has determined that the normal danger of fire in the unincorporated areas of Coke County is greatly enhanced by the extremely dry conditions now existing;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Commissioners Court of Coke County adopts this Order prohibiting the sale or use of restricted fireworks in the unincorporated areas of Coke County.

A. No person may sell, detonate, ignite, or in any way use fireworks classified under 49 C.F.R. part. 173.100(r)(2) (10-1-86 edition), as "skyrockets with sticks" and "missiles with fins" in any portion of the unincorporated area of Coke County.

B. This Order does not prohibit:

1. common fireworks, small in size classified as Class C explosives;

2. large fireworks devices designed primarily to produce visible or audible effects by combustion, deflagration, or detonation and classified as Class B explosive by the U.S. Dept. of Trans. [TEX. OCC. CODE, Chapter 2154].

C. A person commits an offense if the person knowingly or intentionally violates a prohibition established by this Order. An offense under this order is a Class C. Misdemeanor.

One contract is for Texas Tech Water Well Additions and one contract is for Water Supply Line Improvements Material Only. The Texas Tech Water Well Additions contract includes the construction of 2 water wells approximately 317 and 332 feet deep, pumps, piping, valves, flowmeters, electrical, SCADA, and incidentals. The

Water Supply Line Improvements Material Only contract includes furnishing and delivering approximately 1020 linear feet of 6" and 4270 linear feet of 4" PVC water lines as well as valves, fittings, couplings, joint restraints, metal tape and incidentals.
