ORDER PROHIBITING CERTAIN FIREWORKS IN UNINCORPORATED AREAS OF COKE **COUNTY, TEXAS**

WHEREAS, the Texas Forest Service has determined that drought conditions exist in Coke County; and

WHEREAS, on the 14th day 2021, June, Commissioners Court of Coke County has determined that the normal danger of fire in the unincorporated areas of Coke County is greatly enhanced by the extremely dry conditions now existing;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Commissioners Court of Coke adopts this Order County

prohibiting the sale or use of restricted fireworks in the unincorporated areas of Coke

No person may sell, detonate, ignite, or in any way use fireworks classified under 49 C.F.R. part 173.100(r)(2) (10-1-86 edition), as "skyrockets with sticks" and "missiles with fins" any portion of the unincorporated area of Coke County.

- This Order does not prohibit:
- Common fireworks, small in size classified as Class C explosives;
- 2. Large fireworks devices designed primarily to produce visible or audible effects by combustion, deflagration, or detonation and classified as Class B explosive by the US Dept. of Trans. [TEX. OCC. CODE, Chapter 2154].
- C. A person commits an offense if the person knowingly or intentionally violates a prohibition established by this
