Administrator Daisy Toms, Chief Financial Officer Johnny Mathis, and Business Office Manager Fran Sonnenberg were also present. Lanette Fletcher was absent.

Bronte City Council meetings held

March 23, 2020

The Bronte City Council met in regular session on Monday, March 23, 2020, at 5:30 pm. An audio recording can be requested through the Public Information Act through City Hall.

The meeting was called to order at 5:30 pm by Mayor Pro Tem Santiago Rodriguez and a quorum was established. Those in attendance included City Council Members Lee Wommack, Steve Hines, Ron Cooper, and Stormy Vaughn, Mayor Paul Gohman (via telephone) and City Secretary Teresa Ballard.

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Mayor Pro Tem Santiago Rodriguez and prayer was led by Lee Wommack.

Mayor Pro Tem Santiago Rodriguez read item #4, considering extending the

emergency declaration by the mayor. Rodriguez recognized Mayor Gohman via telephone due to his high risk and giving under these circumstances explained to the council the importance of extending the emergency declaration. His recommendation was to ask the council to vote to extend the emergency declaration and table the non-critical items for later.

It was considered to authorize the Mayor or Mayor Pro Tem to execute the Annual Renewal Employee Benefits Coverage with the Texas Municipal Health League.

Consideration was given to an ordinance amending the Fiscal Year 2019-2020 Approved Budget for municipal purposes respecting the General, Water, and Sanitation Fund to transfer budget expenses.
