Ms. Toms the gave Administrator's Report and reported that we have 27







# Bronte City Council meetings held

### March 23, 2020

The Bronte City Council met in regular session on Monday, March 23, 2020, at 5:30 pm. An audio recording can be requested through the Public Information Act through City Hall.

The meeting was called to order at 5:30 pm by Mayor Pro Tem Santiago Rodriguez and a quorum was established. Those in attendance included City Council Members Lee Wommack, Steve Hines, Ron Cooper, and Stormy Vaughn, Mayor Paul Gohman (via telephone) and City Secretary Teresa Ballard.

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Mayor Pro Tem Santiago Rodriguez and prayer was led by Lee Wommack.

Mayor Pro Tem Santiago Rodriguez read item #4, considering extending the

emergency declaration by the Rodriguez recognized mayor.
