Community Watch Meeting! Coke County Judge Hal Spain presented a program at the Robert Lee Community Watch meeting held Tuesday evening, June 18, 2019, at the Family Life Center in Robert Lee. His presentation focused on our tax dollars and the many local entities to which they are distributed. Judge Spain explained that Coke County is tasked with collecting ad valorem (property) taxes for all of the various entities operating within the borders of Coke County. Not every taxpayer pays taxes for every entity, but all taxes are paid to Coke County for distribution. Among these taxing entities are the cities of both Bronte and Robert Lee; Robert Lee ISD, Bronte ISD, Blackwell CISD; West Coke County Hospital District and East Coke County Hospital District; and Coke County Underground Water and Kickapoo Water. Using his tax statement, he went on to show how Coke County receives only a small percentage of the taxes paid each year. For this small percentage, the county is tasked with a long list of duties. Spain provided a list of the top nine of these duties. They are Public Safety and Justice; Vehicle Registration and Transfers; maintaining county owned Roads and Bridges; Elections; Voter Registration; Collection of Property Taxes; Official Recordings - Licenses, Deeds, etc.; Emergency Management; and Health and Safety Services.
