The Bronte City Council met in Regular Session on May 12, 2011. Mayor Gerald Sandusky presided over the meeting. Councilmembers present were Jim Guthrie, Misti Bedford, Jennifer Stango, Buzz Gohman and Paula McWright. City employees present were Water Superintendent Ricky Royall, City Secretary Pat Martindale and Asst. City Secretary Tammy Thorn. Visitors present were Engineers Ken Martin and Brice Campbell.

The Meeting opened with the Pledge of Allegiance and a prayer by Mr. Gohman.

Mr. Martin discussed with the Council the water supply study for the City. Several options of water projects were presented. Mr. Martin suggested that someone from the City should meet with the Upper Colorado River Authority to determine exactly how much water is available to Bronte.
