read: "Caution: Federal law restricts this drug to use by or on the order of a licensed veterinarian."

"This means you need to

with your work closely veterinarian to adjust how your farm accesses animal health products,"Tomascik said.

Tomascik stressed importance of having a veterinarian-client-patientrelationship (VCPR) in order to access the antibiotics.

VCPR. With valid a. veterinarians may make medical judgements prescribe and medications, including antimicrobials or antibiotics, for livestock if the veterinarian believes the owner will follow their instructions.

"A veterinarian is invaluable partner in treating and illnesses managing infections," Tomascik said. "But more importantly, working with your veterinarian throughout the year will help minimize and prevent disease in your livestock."

The rule does not impact the use of vaccines, dewormers, prebiotics, probiotics, topical ionophores. nonantibiotic treatments and nutritional supplements.
