Sterling City and was a past Worshipful Master of the Sterling City Masonic Lodge #728. He was a 32nd degree Scottish Rite and a Shriner. M.C. belonged to the American Legion in Sterling City and served on the Coke County Soil & Water Conservation Board.

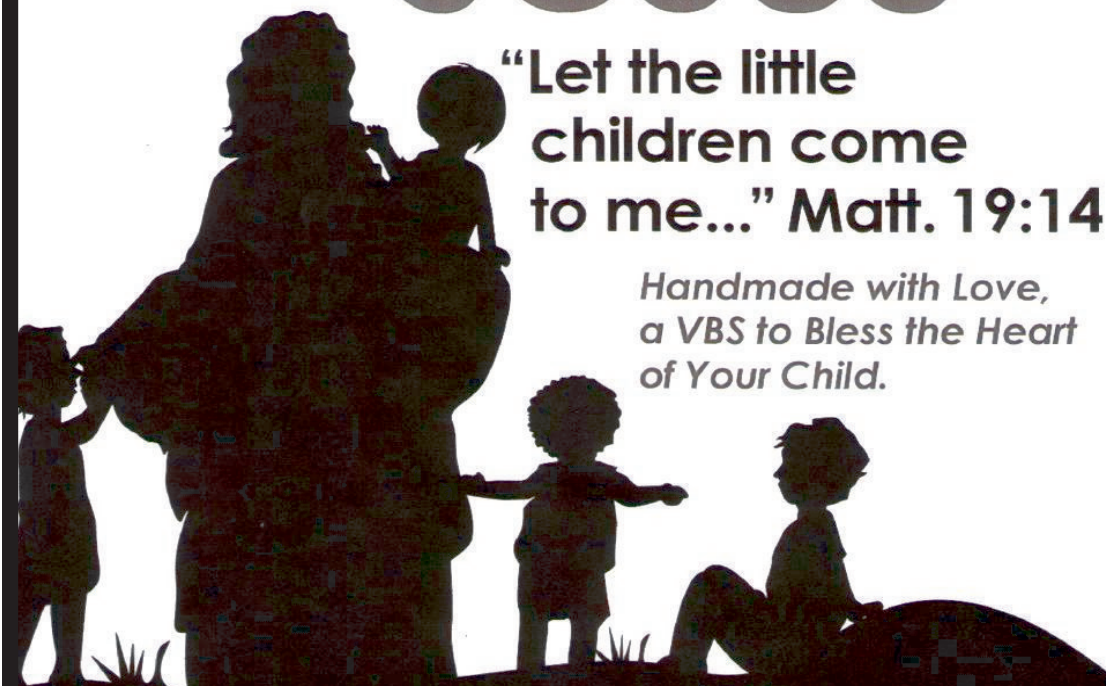
