#### Meeting minutes told

The Board of Directors of the West Coke County Hospital District met in regular session May 28, 2019. President Pat Stephens called the meeting to order at 9:35 am and declared a quorum was present. Board members present were Pat Carwile, Noel Tinkler and Beverly Burdett, and Robert Brock. Houston McGuire, RLCC Administrator, Roger Alexander, WCCHD Administrator, Chris Martin, Consultant, and Janie Munoz, BOM, were also present at the meeting. The invocation was given by Pat Stephens.

There were no visitors.

The board members were sworn in and the following officers were elected: President - Pat Stephens, Vice-President - Beverly Burdett, and Secretary - Pat Carwile.

There were no absent board members from the previous meeting and the minutes from that meeting were approved.

Houston gave the administrator's report. There are 35 residents in the Care Center as of the meeting date and the facility is fully staffed.

Accounts receivable were reviewed and discussed, and the DSO for the month is 53.

Houston reports no major problems at this time in building maintenance.

Houston also shared that the fishing trip for the residents earlier in the month was a tremendous success, and everyone is really looking forward to the next one.

The financial statements were discussed and accepted.

An update on the QIPP program was given, and Houston will send the next IGT payment due June 3.

The board voted to approve a bid for the purchase of property,

## Commissioner's Court meeting held

The Coke County Commissioner's Court met in regular session on Tuesday, May 14, 2019, at the County Courthouse in Robert Lee.

Those in attendance include County Judge Hal Spain, Commissioner Precinct 1 Donald Robertson, Commissioner Precinct 2 Paul Williams, Commissioner Precinct 3 Marshall Millican, and Clerk Monica Reyes. Commissioner Precinct 4 Joe Sefcik was absent.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag and prayer was offered by Commissioner Williams.

Judge Spain announced the presence of a quorum.

Commissioner Millican moved to approve the minutes for April 23, 2019, as written. The motion, seconded by Commissioner Robertson, carried.

The Treasurer's Report was presented by Treasurer Therese Emert. Commissioner Williams moved to approve the Treasurer's Report as presented and was seconded by Commissioner Millican. The motion carried.

Commissioner Robertson moved to approve the payroll as presented. The motion, seconded by Commissioner Williams, carried.

Commissioner Williams moved to approve accounts payable for payroll and was seconded by Commissioner Millican. The motion carried.

Extension Agent Morgan Runyan presented the Extension Report.

Sheriff Wayne McCutchen presented the Sheriff's Report.

The Tax Collector's Report was presented by Judge Spain.

County/District Clerk Monica Reyes presented her report.

Constable Precinct 1 Marty Boyd's report was presented by Judge Spain.

Justice of the Peace Russell Johnson presented his report.

There was no DR Report.

Judge Spain presented the Trapper's Report.

No action was taken on the burn ban.

Commissioner Williams made a motion to acknowledge the order of the appointment of the County Auditor for a 2 year term. The motion, seconded by Commissioner Millican, carried.

Commissioner Williams made a motion to accept the donation to Coke County for labor, materials, and/or funds for maintenance of McDonald County Road. The motion, seconded by Commissioner Robertson, carried.

Commissioner Millican made a motion to approve the line item transfers for the Agriculture Extension office and for the County Treasurer. Commissioner Robertson seconded the motion and the motion carried.

No action was taken on depository bids and will be tabled until the next meeting.

Discussion was held regarding the BNB Tennyson Solar LLC Project. Commissioner Williams made a motion regarding the

pending application for a proposed solar facility project in Coke County. His motion included the following:

1) The Commissioner's Court should review and consider the company's application;

2) The Commissioner's Court should schedule a public hearing to occur at the May 28, 2019, Commissioner's Court meeting regarding the company's proposed tax abatement reinvestment zone, pursuant to all public notice required by law; and

3) The Commissioner's Court should schedule a vote to occur at the May 28, 2019, Commissioner's Court meeting regarding approval of the company's proposed tax abatement reinvestment zone, pursuant to all public notice required by law.

Commissioner's Court closed the regular meeting at 9:28 am, and went in to Executive Session until 10:40 am, at which time the regular session continued.

Commissioner Sefcik made a motion to approve the line item transfer for the Extension Agent and was seconded by Commissioner Robertson. The motion carried.

Commissioner Millican moved to pay bills and was seconded by Commissioner Williams. The motion carried.

Judge Spain adjourned the meeting at 11:33 am.

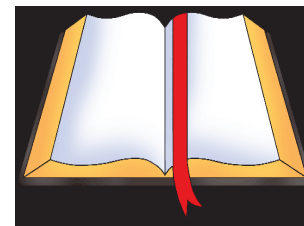
