The 3rd annual Save the Park Fun Day will be held Saturday, June 17, 2017, at the Coke County Park in Bronte.

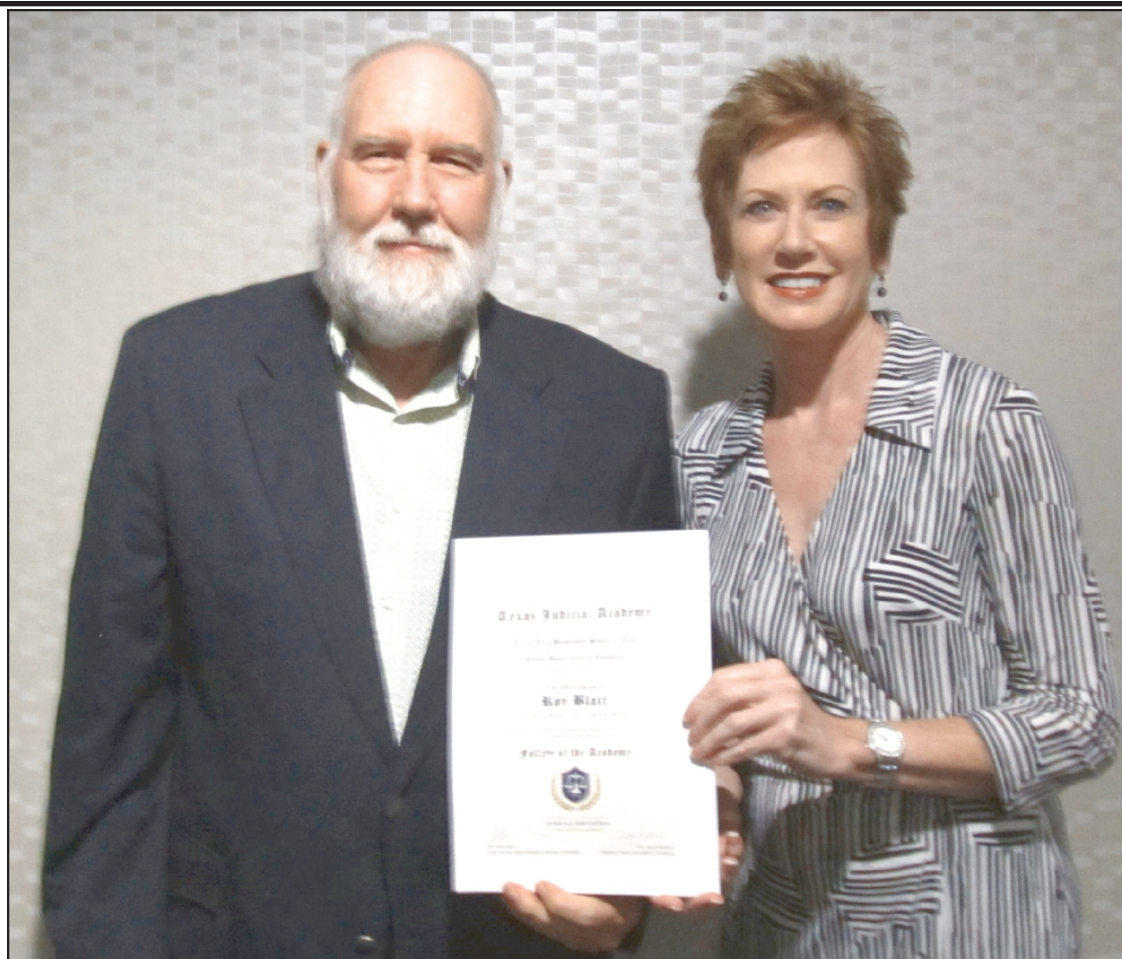
Activities will include a petting zoo, face painting, a foam machine, an obstacle course, a bounce house, a dunking booth, a slip 'n slide, food booths and much more.

Judge Blair was inducted on November 17, 2016, as a Fellow in the Texas Judicial Academy during the 2016 Fall Judicial Education Session. The Texas Judicial Academy, a partnership between the Texas Tech University School of Law and the Texas Association of Counties, recognizes judges who attain significant judicial education above that required by state law as Fellows each year. The educational program of the Texas Judicial Academy is overseen by the Texas Court of Criminal Appeals and includes instruction by higher court judges, law school faculty as well as representatives of the Texas Probate College and the National Judicial College.
