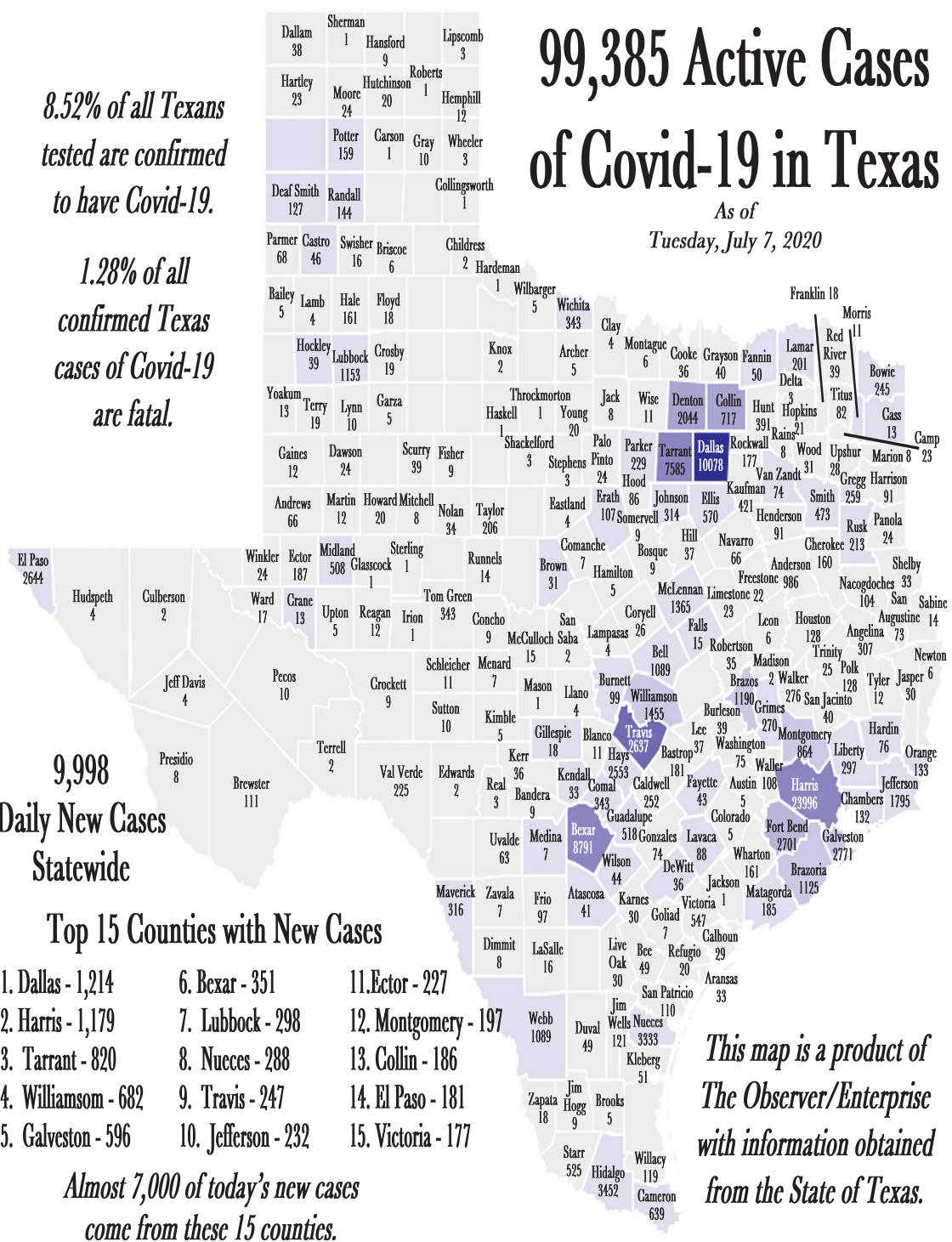
Vehicle Accident! At about 10 pm, Saturday, June 27, 2020, two vehicles crashed on State Highway 208, near the intersection of East 7th Street in Robert Lee. Three people from one vehicle and one person from the other vehicle were injured. An eleven year old was transported to Shannon Hospital by AirMed and the other three victims were transported by West Coke County EMS and East Coke County EMS. Two young people were subsequently transferred to Cook's Children's Hospital in serious condition. Texas Department of Public Safety has charged a San Angelo man with three counts of Intoxication Assault.
