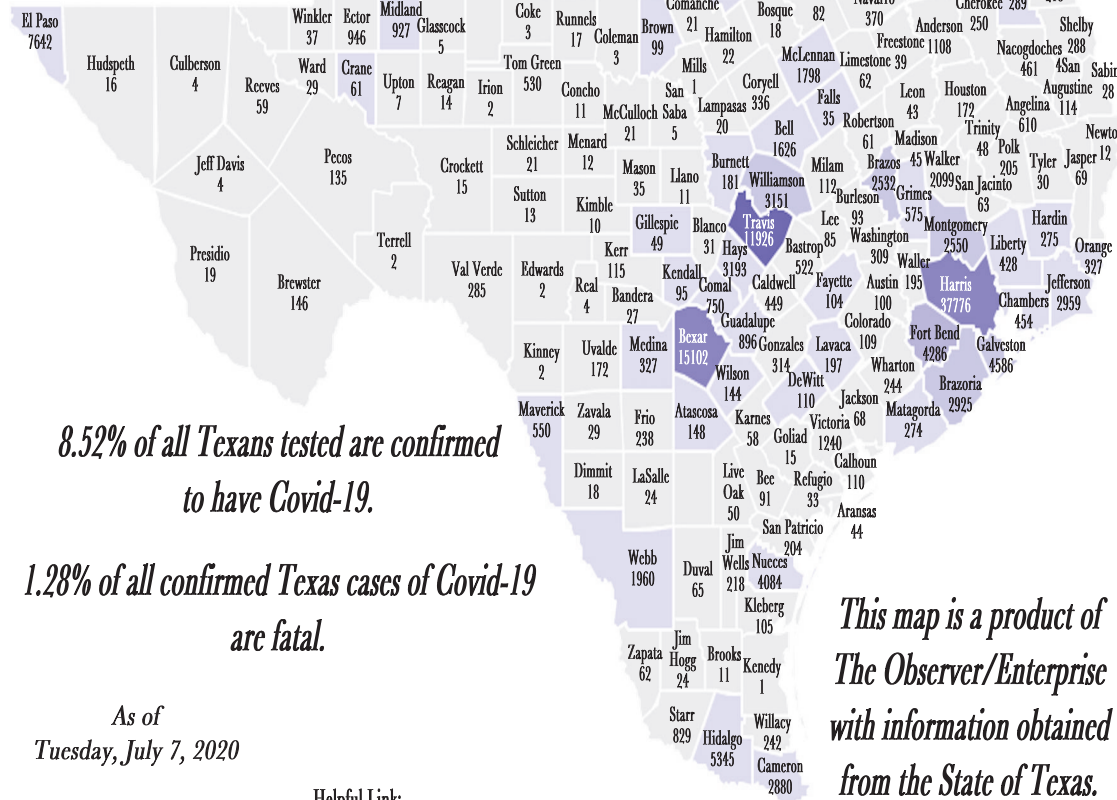
Ricky Royall would like the Council to consider approving a bid of \$7,800 from Bug Express
