### Preschool Program for Children with Disabilities and Pre-Kindergarten

**Leadership Conference!** A Sterling County student has returned from Texas Farm Bureau's 56th annual Youth Leadership Conference (YLC). Dain Copeland (right) represented Coke-Sterling Farm Bureau at the conference this year.

"YLC is a great opportunity for our students to gain the knowledge and skills they need to become the next generation of leaders," John Ross Copeland, Coke-Sterling Farm Bureau president said. "Dain Copeland is well on his way to becoming a successful young leader after attending this great conference."

Students who attend YLC engage in goal-setting activities that help build character, confidence, and leadership skills. Students also learn about the free enterprise system and how it's the foundation that enables America to prosper.


