The rehab includes recoating the interior and exterior of the tank and replacing miscellaneous appurtenances.

Bids may be held by the Owner for a period not to exceed 60 days from the date of bid opening for the purpose of reviewing the bids and investigating the qualifications of Bidders prior to awarding of the contract.
