The Coke County Commissioners Court met in special session June 23, 2014, at the courthouse in Robert Lee. Members of the court present included County Judge, Roy Blair, Commissioner, Pct. #1 Troy Montgomery, Commissioner, Pct. #2 Wendell Lee, Commissioner, Pct. #3 Gaylon Pitcock, Commissioner,

Pct. #4 Bobby Blaylock. Deputy clerk Martha Ratliff was also in attendance.

The meeting opened with prayer given by Commissioner Blaylock and pledge to the flag

was recited.

Judge Blair announced the presence of a quorum.

No action was taken on the burn ban.

Comm. Pitcock made a motion seconded by Comm. Montgomery to purchase coal mix for Precinct 2 & 4. Motion carried.

Comm. Pitcock made a motion seconded by Comm. Lee to approve resolution on submitting clean water act resolution to EPA. Motion carried.

Comm. Lee made a motion seconded by Comm. Montgomery to approve the joint resolution and memorandum of agreement by and between Coke County and Tom Green County regarding the consolidation of the 911 (PSAP).

Comm. Blaylock reported TCEQ is scheduled for inspection of the Bronte Lake on July 9th. Judge Blair reported that the Extension Office has an opening for a part time secretary.

There being no private road requests, no action was taken.

Comm. Lee made a motion seconded by Comm. Blaylock to approve the payment of bills. Motion carried.

Judge Blair adjourned the meeting at 9:30 am.
