Robert Lee woman indicted on murder charge

A Coke County Grand Jury indicted Jasmine Moreno Thursday, July 12, 2018, for the murder of her husband, Cisco Moreno. On Tuesday, June 26, 2018, Mrs. Moreno was taken into custody and booked into Runnels County Jail. She was released the following day after posting bond.

During an interview with Coke County Sheriff Wayne McCutchen and Texas Ranger Nick Hanna, Mrs. Moreno admitted to shooting Mr. Moreno multiple times in the kitchen of their home on Euel Street in Robert Lee early Sunday morning, June 24, 2018, during a domestic dispute.
