BRONTE SETS  
VOLUNTARY WATER  
RESTRICTIONS**

The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has asked all water systems to implement their drought contingency plans. This will help extend availability of a necessary precious resource.

In response to this request, the Bronte City Council has implemented Stage 1 of the Drought Contingency Plan. Stage 1 asks for voluntary water conservation with no outside watering between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. City of Bronte's water resources have not reached a level that would normally trigger Stage 1 of the drought contingency plan.

All customers are asked to comply with this request beginning on Monday, July 24th.

MCL COLIFORM  
VIOLATION (TCR 22)**

The City of Robert Lee Public Water Supply/ PWS ID0410002 water system collected (2) water samples during June, 2011, that contained coliform bacteria. This water system is required to submit a minimum of three routine water samples each month for

bacteriological analysis. Three routine samples were coliform-found and seven repeat sample were coliform-found for the month and year indicated above.

The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) sets drinking water standards in Texas and has determined that the presence of total coliform is a possible health concern. Coliforms are bacteria that are naturally present in the environment and are used as an indicator that other, potentially-harmful, bacteria may be present. Coliforms were found in more samples than allowed and this was a warning of potential problems.

For water systems analyzing at least 40 samples per month, no more than five (5) percent of the monthly samples may be positive for total coliform. For systems analyzing fewer than 40 samples per month, no more than one (1) sample per month may be positive for total coliform.
