 The Robert Lee City Council met in regular session on Thursday, June 17, 2021, at 6:30 pm at City Hall.

Those in attendance included Mayor Jason Moran; Council Members Tracy Grantham, Josh Tennison, David Lewis, Jonathan Torres, and Daniel Jasso; and City Attorney Jeff Betty.

The Consent Agenda, which included minutes from May 20, 2021, Animal Control Report, Municipal Court Report, Ordinance Enforcement Report, EMS Report, RLVFD Report, and the Financial Report were discussed. A motion was made by Mayor Pro Tem Tracy Grantham to approve of the Consent Agenda. She was seconded by David Lewis and the motion carried with a vote of 5 - 0.

Discussion was held regarding the Bronte Water Plant. Bronte is going to purchase a new water plant to better serve their customers, which includes Robert Lee as their biggest one. It was considered going in to business with Bronte and their water system. A motion was made by Daniel Jasso to authorize Mayor Jason Moran to look into more options regarding the water plant. He was seconded by Josh Tennison and the motion carried with a vote of 5 - 0.

The City of Robert Lee is not currently in a contract with a sanitation company for trash
