 A very important factor to consider is the Trauma Service Area and number of hospitalizations. Coke County falls in Trauma Area K which includes the following counties – Tom Green, Coke, Runnels, Sterling, Irion, Reagan, Crockett, Concho, McCulloch,

Mason, Menard, Schleicher, Sutton and Kimble. As of July 27, there were 81 “lab-confirmed Covid-19 patients in hospitals” in Area K. Area K has a total population of 179,457 with 440 staffed hospital beds. Currently available are 200 hospital beds, 8 ICU beds and 39 ventilators.

The Trauma Service Area our northern border is Area D Nolan, Mitchell, Coleman, serving adjoining counties on serving these counties – Taylor, Brown, Comanches, Stephens,
