(Continued from previous page) A very important factor to consider is the Trauma Service and number hospitalizations. Coke County falls in Trauma Area K which includes the following counties Tom Green, Coke, Runnels, Irion, Reagan, Crockett, Concho, McCulloch,

Mason, Menard, Schleicher, Sutton and Kimble. As of July 27, there were 81 "labconfirmed Covid-19 patients in hospitals" in Area K. Area K has a total population of 179,457 with 440 staffed hospital beds. Currently available are 200 hospital beds, 8 ICU beds and 39 ventilators.
