All high touch areas will be disinfected throughout the day. The cafeteria will be disinfected regularly. Staff will have access to supplies to clean/disinfect working surfaces and shared objects after each use and during breaks in instruction. Alcohol-based hand sanitizing stations will be located throughout the building and in all teachers' classrooms. Families with the ability to do so are encouraged to transport their child to and from school, however bus transportation will still be offered. Due to the standard number of transported students, the ability to social

distance is compromised. For this reason, students utilizing bus transportation may be required to wear face coverings/masks at all times on board as developmentally appropriate. Hand sanitizer will be available when boarding the bus and bus drivers will wear face coverings/masks. Buses will be cleaned/disinfected between each transportation run and at the end of the day.

The cafeteria and serving areas will be cleaned between uses but students may eat in various locations throughout the building to maximize social distancing. The cafeteria will be closed to visitors.

Parents will not be permitted to walk students inside the school building beyond the secure vestibule without a mask. Whenever possible, parents should remain in vehicles during all pick-ups. Dismissal exit points will be established.

Water fountains will not be accessible. Students should bring their own water bottle to school.

Whenever possible, physical education classes will be held outside to allow for maximum social distancing between students.

In the event that suspected/confirmed cases of Covid-19 exceed 10% of facility occupancy, all RLISD facilities will close for a minimum of 14 days, with students and staff moving to School-to-Home learning model. All school facilities and buses will be disinfected. All auxiliary areas, such as playgrounds and athletic fields, will be closed, and extracurricular activities will be canceled. There will also be district-wide communication to staff/parents with self-health monitoring guidance.

Regardless of the learning model, all Robert Lee ISD students will receive social and emotional support every day. Implementation of this includes:

- Teacher professional development on social and emotional learning (SEL) and

trauma-informed classrooms.

- Students in-class and online activities on RLISD core values, social and emotional learning,

- following specific SEL and Responsible Decision competencies (Self-Awareness, Making Self-Management, Social Awareness, Relationship Skills, Mental health supports for students and employees.

Dear Parent/Guardian:

Children need healthy meals to learn. *Bronte ISD* offers healthy meals every school day. Breakfast costs **\$0** lunch costs *Pre-K - 5th \$3.00, 6th - 12th \$3.25*. **Your children may qualify for free meals or for reduced-price meals.** Reduced price is **\$0**, for breakfast and **\$40** for lunch. If you received a notification letter that a child is directly certified for free ore reduced-price meals, do not complete an application. Let the school know if any children in the household attending school are not listed in the letter.

The questions and answers that follow will provide additional information on how to complete the application. Complete only one application for all the students in the household and return the completed application to Bronte ISD, PO Box 670, Bronte, Texas 76933, Phone (325) 473-2511. 1. Who can get free meals?

- **Income**-Children can get free or reduced-price meals if a household's gross income is within the limits described in the Federal Income Eligibility Guidelines.
- **Special Assistance Program Participants**- Children in households receiving benefits from the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations (FDPIR), or Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF), are eligible for free meals.
- **Foster**-Foster children who are under the legal responsibility of a foster care agency or court are eligible for free meals.
- **Head Start or Early Head Start**-Children participating in these programs are eligible for free meals.
- **Homeless, Runaway, and Migrant**-Children who meet the definition of homeless, runaway, or migrant qualify for free meals. If you haven't been told about a child's status as homeless, runaway, or migrant or you feel a child may qualify for one of these programs, please call or email Daisy Sanchez, 325-473-2511 ext. 119, daisy.sanchez@bronteisd.net.
- **WIC Recipient**-Children in households participating in WIC may be eligible for free or reduced price meals.

2. What if I disagree with the school's decision about my application? Talk to school officials. You also may ask for a hearing by calling or writing to **Tim Siler, P.O. Box 670, Bronte, Texas 76933 Phone 325-473-2511, ext. 111, tim.siler@bronteisd.net.**

3. My child's application was approved last year. Do I need to fill out a new one? Yes. An application is only good for that school year and the first few days of this school year. You must send in a new application unless the school told you that your child is eligible for this school year.
