
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Let's Go Longhorns! Recently, the Bronte Varsity Cheerleaders placed third overall in small varsity and cheer competition and third in extreme routine.

Judge Blair announced the presence of a quorum.


Commissioner Robertson moved to accept the minutes for May 23, 2017. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Sefcik. The motion carried.
