Board members present were Pat Stephens, Betty Lewis, Roma McCarley and Noel Tinkler. Houston McGuire, Administrator, Janie Munoz, BOM, and Roger Alexander, Consultant, were also present at the meeting. The minutes from the previous meeting were approved. One absent Board member was excused from the previous meeting.

The Administrator gave his report.

In the staffing update, there is a need for nurses, although the facility is currently fully staffed.

A bid from RLCC for the lot across the street has been accepted is still awaiting signatures. The area will be cleared for the future site of some much needed parking places for the facility.

Future agenda items were discussed.

The next regular meeting of the Board of Directors will be July 26, 2022 in the Board Conference Room.
