The Board of Directors of the West Coke County Hospital District met in regular session June 28, 2022, in the Board Conference Room.

President Beverly Burdett called the meeting to order at 9:35 am, declared a quorum was present, and Pat Stephens led the invocation. Board members present were Pat Stephens, Betty Lewis, Roma McCarley and Noel Tinkler. Houston McGuire, Administrator, Janie Munoz, BOM, and Roger Alexander, Consultant, were also present at the meeting. The minutes from the previous meeting were approved. One absent Board member was excused from the previous meeting.

The Administrator gave his report.

In the staffing update, there is a need for nurses, although the facility is currently fully staffed.

There are currently 39 residents as of the meeting date.

Covid testing is back on a biweekly basis for those who have not had the shots, due to County numbers. There are no active cases in the facility at this time.

Danco Electric is still waiting on parts for the electrical work. The possible future start date is November.

In landscaping update, the sprinkler system has been repaired and is working well, although one or two sprinkler heads still need to be replaced.

Houston reported he has outstanding calls to different contractor for the outside improvements to the facility. It's been difficult to find someone during these post covid times.

Houston also reported some plumbing issues that are in the process of being addressed.

The use of Cross HealthCare continues to be very advantageous to the facility.

The QIPP update was good and the DSO stands at 64.

The Audit for last year is totally complete.

The facility's move to paperless charting is going well.

The financial report was discussed and approved.

A copy of the revised Employee Handbook was passed out to the Board Members for review. It is on next month's agenda.

A bid from RLCC for the lot across the street has been accepted is still awaiting signatures. The area will be cleared for the future site of some much needed parking places for the facility.

Future agenda items were discussed.

The next regular meeting of the Board of Directors will be July 26, 2022 in the Board Conference Room.

The meeting then adjourned, and the Board enjoyed some delicious grilled burgers and all the trimmin's at the facility.

The July calendar looks like a busy summer month. On July 1, a July 4th decorating contest will be held in the facility, with prizes given to the top 3 winners. The actual 4th of July will be celebrated by the residents with popcorn and a movie that afternoon. On the 5th of July, Buzz and Virginia McMillan
