CITY OF ROBERT LEE
PUBLIC NOTICE TO
BOIL WATER
AUGUST 8, 2011

Due to reduced pressure resulting from a water main break, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) has required the City of Robert Lee's Water Treatment Plant to notify all customers to boil their water prior to consumption.

To ensure destruction of all harmful bacteria and other microbes, water for drinking, cooking, and for making ice should be boiled and cooled prior to consumption. The water should be brought to a vigorous rolling boil and then boiled for two minutes. In lieu of boiling, you may purchase bottled water or obtain water from some other suitable source.

When it is no longer necessary to boil the water, the water system officials will notify you in the same manner as this notice.

AUGUST 9, 2011

Water samples were received resulting in negative coliform bacteria and the boil notice was rescinded.

After the conclusion date, all marks and brands that have not been re-registered are automatically available for registration by another party. The cost of registering brands in Coke County is \$16.00. Each additional location is \$5.00 if registered at the same time.

To be eligible for the scholarship, a student must be:

- o A Texas resident;

- o Classified as a "Freshman" or in first year after high school in the accredited program;
- o Majoring in a natural resource related field such as agricultural science, wildlife science, forestry, range science, etc.;
- o A citizen of the United States and provide a valid social security number if chosen

Students must also maintain 12 hours per semester and a minimum 2.0 GPA per semester and 2.5 cumulative GPA.

The scholarships are awarded based on overall quality and on essay responses to a series of natural resource questions.
