August 13, 2021

To: All interested Agencies, Groups, and Individuals

This is to give notice that the City of Bronte has conducted an evaluation as required by Executive Order 11988 and/or 11990, in accordance with HUD regulations at 24 CFR 55.20 Subpart C Procedures for Making Determinations Floodplain Management, determine the potential affect that its activity in the floodplain and wetland will have on the human environment for a proposed water improvements project under the Texas Community Development Grant Program (TxCDBG). The City of Bronte, Texas has been funded for a water system improvements project as a Community Development Fund project under the Texas Community Development Block Grant Program (TxCDBG) for nonentitlement cities and counties. The purpose of the TxCDBG project (#7220059) is to make water system improvements in The proposed TxCDBG project involves replacement of approximately four thousand five hundred linear feet of six-inch and eightinch water lines, boring, fire hydrants, and related service reconnections.

Completion of the proposed

project will have no negative impact on the local environmental and will benefit all the residents within the City of Bronte. A small portion of the proposed project is located in the flood zone. The proposed project does not intend to extend service to any new customers in this flood zone, nor does it intend to promote the development in the flood zone. proposed water improvements will be installed in a manner as to prevent damage in the event of a flood.

The City of Bronte has considered the following alternatives and mitigation measures to be taken minimize adverse impacts and to restore and preserve natural and beneficial values: (1) Relocating the water system improvements. Relocation of the water lines is not a feasible option as these water lines need to be replaced to address problems within the distribution system; and (2) Opting to not complete the proposed water improvements. This alternative will not meet the needs of the City of Bronte and its citizens. Failure to not replace the old deteriorated water lines will not address the problem of water loss and water line breaks.

The City of Bronte has reevaluated the alternatives to building in the floodplain and has determined that it hasno practicable alternative. The project engineer will prepare detailed engineering plans and specifications in a manner to prevent damage to the system. The City will request that the engineer include specifications that the water lines be installed to prevent damage in the event of a flood. Environmental files that document compliance with

steps 3 through 6 of Executive Order 11988 and/or 11990, are available for public inspection, review and copying upon request at the times and location delineated in the last paragraph of this notice for receipt of comments. This activity will have no significant impact on the environment for following reasons: (1) A minor portion of the proposed project will be located in the floodplain, but there is no anticipated adverse impact on the project from the floodplain nor is there expected any adverse impact on the floodplain because of the construction; (2) The project will not have a permanent adverse effect on natural or beneficial floodplain values; and (3) The NFIP construction standards will be complied with as they relate to the construction of the water improvements.

There are three primary purposes for this notice. First, people who may be affected by activities in floodplains and those who have an interest in the protection of the natural environment should be given an opportunity to express their and provide information about these areas. Second, an adequate public notice program can be an important public educational

The dissemination of information about floodplains can facilitate and enhance Federal efforts to reduce the risks associated with the occupancy and modification of these special areas. Third, as a matter of fairness, when the Federal government determines it will participate in actions taking place in floodplains, it must inform those who may be put at greater
