West Coke County Hospital Board minutes posted

The Board of Directors of the West Coke County Hospital District met in regular session July 30, 2013. President Mary Bessent called the meeting to order and declared a quorum was present. Other Board members present were Sarah Green, Dessie Kendall, and Pat Carwile. Roger Alexander, Administrator, and Janie Munoz, BOM, were also present at the meeting.

Minutes from the previous meeting were approved and there were no absent Board members from that meeting.

I was absent from the regular July meeting, but the information in my Board packet informed me there are currently 39 residents in the facility as of the meeting date.

The items on the agenda discussed at the meeting were accounts receivable, financial statements, and capital projects. An update will be posted later in this report. The Board also discussed setting up a budget workshop date. The next regularly scheduled meeting will be Tuesday, August 27, 2013.

There was a called Board meeting August 9, convening at 9:40 am. All the members were present at that meeting. The invocation was led by Dessie

Kendall, and there were no visitors. Roger updated the Board on expenditures made for a new dryer and repairs to the grease trap. He also stated the renovated wing is ready for occupation. It is a lovely addition to the facility, and everyone is encouraged to come by and see it.

The Board asked Roger to continue contacting architects for the next phase of the facility renovation.

The Board went into Executive session at 11 am and returned to regular session at 12:20 pm. No action was required.

Upcoming budget hearings and the tax rate were discussed. A preliminary budget was presented to the Board for discussion and review. There will be two budget hearings, each held in the administrator's office. The first is scheduled for Tuesday, August 20, at 9:30 am, and the second is Friday, August 23, at 9:30 am. The tax rate will be the same as last year, but due to valuation increase, the tax from the average home will increase \$1.19 per year.

Let's take a quick look at the August calendar. On the 10th, the Assembly of God gospel singers were at the facility performing

some good ol' gospel songs for everyone. The monthly birthday party was on the 13th, at 3:30 pm.
