President Mary Bessent called the meeting to order and declared a quorum was present. Other Board members present were Sarah Green, Dessie Kendall, and Pat Carwile. Roger Alexander, Administrator, and Janie Munoz, BOM, were also present at the meeting.

Minutes from the previmeeting were approved and there were no absent Board members from that meeting.

I was absent from the regular July meeting, but the information in my Board packet informed me there are currently 39 residents in the facility as of the meeting date.

The items on the agenda discussed at the meeting were accounts receivable, financial statements, and capital projects. An update will be posted later in this report. The Board also discussed setting up a budget workshop date. The next regularly scheduled meeting will be Tuesday, August 27, 2013.

There was a called Board meeting August 9, convening at 9:40 am. All the
