City Council Update! The Robert Lee City Council met Monday evening, August 12, 2019. Following the pledge, prayer and citizen comments, they moved on to the Consent Agenda. One of the items on this Consent Agenda were the minutes of the previous meeting. The mayor mentioned to the council that although she had emailed copies of the minutes to be approved, she had failed to print out copies of these minutes for their packets. She then advised the minutes be pulled off the Consent Agenda and approved at the next council meeting. The council agreed with that recommendation. The postponement of this approval would be a non-event except for the fact that minutes cannot be publicly printed until they are approved. The Observer/Enterprise has received a verified report of a July 22 special meeting of the council where they voted to award the mayor "back pay" upwards of \$20,000 that would correlate to the mayor receiving \$48,000 in salary and stipend payments during her 24 month term of office. Once these minutes have been approved and are available to the public, the O/E will publish the complete story of how this issue came up for a vote and why the council approved these funds.
