ORDINANCE NO. 19-03 MANUFACTURED HOUSING ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BRONTE, TEXAS, AND REPEALING REPLACING ORDINANCE AND ANNO. 413 ORDINANCE OF 10-10-2013; MOBILE PROHIBITING HOMES WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS: REGULATING THE PLACEMENT AND INSTALLATION OF HUD-CODE MANUFACTURED HOMES AND MODULAR COMPONENTS IN THE REQUIRING CITY; PERMITS AND ESTABLISHING FEES FOR SAME; ESTABLISHING A MANUFACTURED HOUSING DISTRICT; PROBIBITING MANUFACTURED HOUSING PARKS; VARIANCE **PROVIDING** PROCEDURES; FOR **PROVIDING** REPLACEMENT OF NON-CONFORMING HOMES IN CERTAIN INSTANCES; REGULATING THE USE OF RECREATIONAL **FOR** VEHICLES RESIDENCY; PROVIDING A PENALTY CLAUSE; PROVIDING REPEALER SEVERABILITY AND AND CLAUSES; **PROVIDING FOR** PUBLICATION AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

SECTION 16 - PENALTY FOR NON-COMPLIANCE

Any person, firm, or corporation violating this Ordinance or any part of this Ordinance or providing false information to a City official licensing concerning permitting under this Ordinance and found guilty by the Judge of the Municipal Court, will be guilty of a Class C Misdemeanor, and be fined not more than \$500.00 (Five hundred Dollars) except for health violations which may be fined not more than \$2,000.00 (Two Thousand Dollars). Each day such violation continues, or be permitted to continue, shall be a separate violation.

EPA dismisses call to ban chlorpyrifos

Farmers, golf course managers and families across the U.S. may continue to use products containing the insecticide chlorpyrifos to battle flies, mosquitoes and other pests.

The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) recently announced it will allow

the continued use of the insecticide, because the agency does not have enough information and evidence that it is a neurological hazard to justify a ban.

EPA's announcement on July 18 was in response to a court ruling in late April.

The U.S. Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit granted a petition ordering EPA to issue a "full and fair decision" on an objection to the insecticide's use filed in 2007.

The League of United Latin American Citizens and several environmental groups sought a ban on chlorpyrifos and asked EPA to cancel all of its tolerances, citing concerns it can harm farm workers and children.

The court gave EPA 90 days to answer the petition.

Despite its rejection of the ban, EPA officials said they will take the groups' concerns into consideration when considering the renewal of chlorpyrifos' registration, which is due by 2022.

Following the announcement, U.S. Secretary of Agriculture Sonny Perdue tweeted that for more than 50 crops, chlorpyrifos is the only line of defense and is a cost-effective crop protection tool for farmers.

"We appreciate the EPA's support of American farmers and producers in its commitment to fact-based regulatory oversight of crop protection tools," Purdue tweeted.

Chlorpyrifos, an organophosphate, is the main ingredient in products like Lorsban and Dursban. It has been used in the U.S. since 1965 to control pests such as termites, mosquitos and roundworms in both agricultural and non-agricultural areas.

Farmers may use it to target soybean aphids, spider mites and corn rootworm.

In terms of total pounds, chlorpyrifos is most often used on corn, according to EPA.

The insecticide is also used by golf courses on turf, in greenhouses and as a treatment

on utility poles and fence posts. Chlorpyrifos is labeled for use as a mosquito adulticide stations in and in roach and ant bait packaging.

Children need healthy meals to learn. *Bronte ISD* offers healthy meals every school day. 1. Who can get free meals?

 Income-Children can get free or reduced-price meals if a household's gross income is within the limits described in the Federal Income Eligibility Guidelines.

• Special Assistance Program Participants- Children in households receiving benefits from the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations (FDPIR), or Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF), are eligible for free meals.

• Foster-Foster children who are under the legal responsibility of a foster care agency or court are igible for free meals.

• Head Start, Early Head Start, and Even Start-Children participating in these programs are eligible for free meals.

• Homeless, Runaway, and Migrant-Children who meet the definition of homeless, runaway, or migrant qualify for free meals. If you haven't been told about a child's status as homeless, runaway, or migrant or you feel a child may qualify for one of these programs, please call or email Daisy Sanchez, 325-473-2511 ext. 119, daisy.sanchez@bronteisd.net.

• WIC Recipient-Children in households participating in WIC <u>may</u> be eligible for free or reduced price meals.

2. What if I disagree with the school's decision about my application? Talk to school officials. You also may ask for a hearing by calling or writing to Tim Siler, P.O. Box 670, Bronte, Texas 76933 Phone 325-473-2511, ext. 111, tim.siler@bronteisd.net.

3. My child's application was approved last year. Do I need to fill out a new one? Yes. An application is only good for that school year and the first few days of this school year. You must send in a new application unless the school told you that your child is eligible for this school year.
