1. PRAYER: The meeting was opened at 7:13 pm with a prayer by David McWright.

2. ROLL CALL AND ESTABLISH QUORUM: Quorum was established with six members present. John Seales was absent.

3. AUDIENCE ITEMS: No

A. Finance Update: Mr. Siler gave an update on school finances. He went over some large payments including those to Menard Special Education and needed computer updates. He advised the prior report was incorrect on the revenue due to some wrong codes, but has been corrected. He also advised local property revenue was over estimated slightly. A little more spending is being done this time of year compared to last year due to some payroll differences.
