Most residents' bills should run \$110 or more, depending on their water usage. This is for residential basic water, residential sewer, and a roll trash cart. A small business would pay at least \$50 for base water, \$52 for a dumpster and \$17.81 for sewer. In addition, the city collects \$5.02 for the water debt fund and \$1.25 for the capital improvement fund.

In the past, customers have donated \$2 for the Robert Lee Volunteer Fire Department each month. New forms must be signed if a resident chooses to continue making a donation each month to RLVFD and EMS.
