ORDINANCE NO. 19-06 CARGO CONTAINERS, **SHIPPING CONTAINERS** AND SEA CONTAINERS

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF **BRONTE** PROHIBITING THE PLACEMENT OF PERMANENT CARGO, SHIPPING OR SEA CONTAINERS WITHIN THE CITY OF BRONTE; REQUIRING A PERMIT FOR **PLACEMENT OF** TEMPORARY CONTAINERS; PROVIDING STANDARDS FOR USE OF TEMPORARY CONTAINERS; PROVIDING FOR CONTINUATION OF NON-CONFORMING USES; PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE; **PROVIDING** REPEALER AND CLAUSES; SEVERABILITY **PROVIDING FOR** EFFECTIVE DATE.

SECTION 7 – VIOLATIONS **AND PENALTIES**

Any person, firm, or corporation found guilty of violating this Ordinance shall be charged with a Class C misdemeanor and, if convicted, shall be subject to a fine of up to \$500.00 plus court costs. Each and every day the continues violation

constitute a separate offense. In addition to and cumulative of all other penalties, the City of Bronte

shall have the right to seek injunctive relief for any and all violations of this Ordinance.
