The meeting was opened with prayer by Doug Tounget.

The Board approved the PDAS calendar and the student code of conduct. All voted in favor.

The athletic code of conduct was reviewed.

Approval was given for 2011-2012 athletic passes, \$50.00 for individual and \$75.00 for family. All voted in favor.

The Board approved the Property and Auto insurance, accepted Borden for milk bids, approved amendments to 2010-2011 budget,
