

# WCCHD board meeting minutes told

The Board of Directors of the West Coke County Hospital District met in regular session July 26, 2022, in the Board Conference Room. President Beverly Burdett called the meeting to order at 9:35 am, and declared a quorum was present. Pat Stephens led the invocation. Board members present were Pat Stephens and Betty Lewis. Houston McGuire, Administrator, Janie Munoz, BOM, and Roger Alexander, Consultant, were also present at the meeting. The minutes from the previous meeting were approved. There were no absent Board members from the previous meeting.

The Administrator gave his report.

In the staffing update, there is a need for nurses, although the facility is currently fully staffed. There are currently 38 residents as of the meeting date, with none pending.

Covid testing is back on a biweekly basis for those who have not had the shots, due to County numbers. There are no active cases in the facility at this time.

Danco Electric is still waiting on parts for the electrical work.

In landscaping update, the sprinkler system has been repaired and is working well, although one or two sprinkler heads still need to be replaced.

Houston reported he has outstanding calls to different contractors for the outside improvements to the facility.

The yearly State survey of the facility occurred last week and went extremely well. The facility is currently at 4-Star status.

The use of Cross HealthCare continues to be very advantageous to the facility.

The QIPP update was good and the DSO stands at 57.

Copies of the completed audit were made available to the Board.

The financial report was discussed and approved.

The Board voted to approve changes in the Employee Handbook effective August 1, 2022.

A bid from RLCC for the lot

across the street has been accepted is still awaiting signatures.

Future agenda items were discussed, and there will be a budget workshop August 9th in preparation for the new fiscal year.

The next regular meeting of the Board of Directors will be August 30, 2022 in the Board Conference Room.

The meeting then adjourned.
