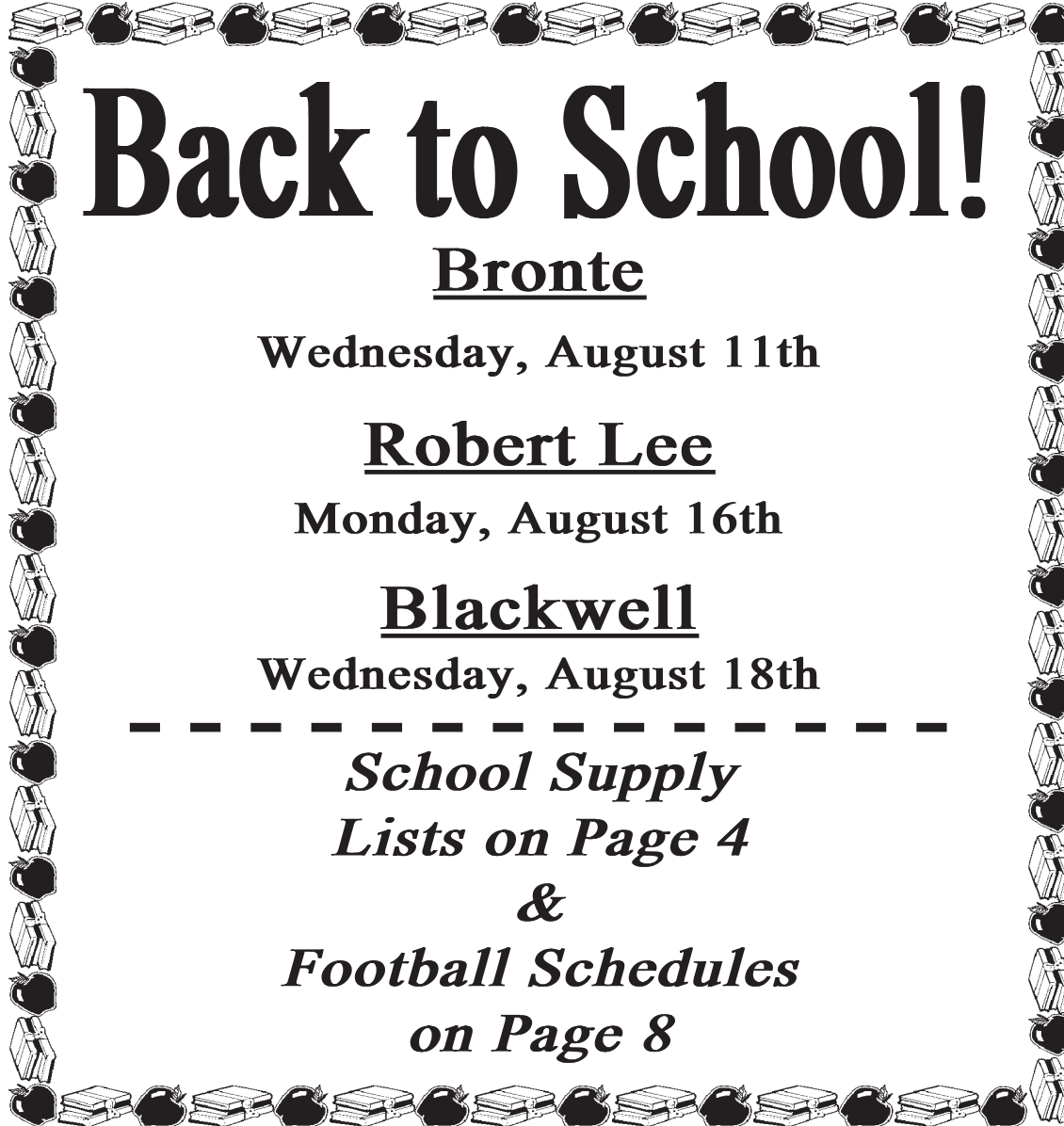

Medal of Honor dedication ceremony to be held

On Friday, August 13, 2021, at 10 am, the Fort Chadbourne Foundation, along with Medal of Honor Recipients Major General

Patrick Brady and Robert "Bob" O'Malley, will be hosting a memorial dedication ceremony for Medal of Honor recipient Peter Roth. Roth received his medal for actions during the Indian Wars Period at Washita River, Texas in 1874. Many of the earlier Civil War and Indian War Medal of Honor recipients have no recognition whatsoever. Fort Chadbourne was approached by the Congressional Medal of Honor Society about placing a memorial stone at the fort to honor Roth. The marble headstone was furnished by the Congressional Medal of Honor Society and will be placed near the Gold Star Families Memorial.

The unveiling and dedication is open to the public and everyone is encouraged to attend. It is also a wonderful opportunity to meet two of our nation's greatest heroes. The
