### Preschool Program for Children with Disabilities and Pre-Kindergarten

\*Extra Clothing - 1 set (to remain at school in case of an accident)

- Please include shirt, pants, underwear, and a pair of socks

- Please consider clothing that will allow your child to dress independently and provide ease while going to the restroom (ex. belts can be difficult for children to unbuckle in a timely fashion to prevent accidents)
