### USDA Food distribution set for September 12

Food distributions will be held in Bronte and Robert Lee on Saturday, September 12, 2020. The Farmers to Families program was developed to support the U.S. farmers and families struggling because of the Covid-19 pandemic.

The United States Department of Agriculture purchases fresh produce, dairy products, fluid milk and meat products that farmers and ranchers cannot sell because of closed restaurants, markets, food processors, etc. This food is give to struggling families free of charge. No identification or registration is required to receive a food box.

Concho Valley Regional Food Bank will bring the food to Coke County where our local food pantries will assist with distribution. The food boxes will be distributed through a drive-by pickup. Distribution in

Bronte is set for 9 am to 10:30 am in the Bronte ISD parking lot. Distribution in Robert Lee is set for 10 am to 11:30 in the Courthouse parking lot.

If you know a family who this distribution would help but are unable to attend the pickup, feel free to pick up a box for them.
